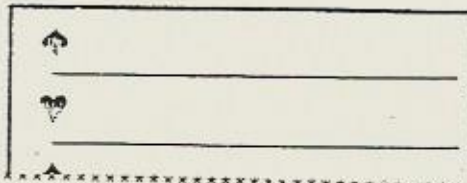

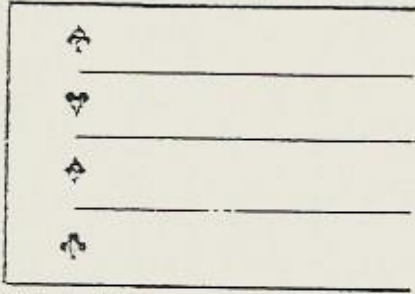

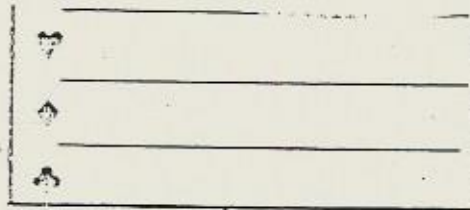

Steve Fishpool was the only declarer to bid and make four spades. He was the king of hearts with the ace, noting South's peter, played a spade to the king and ace. Then a club to the king (ducked by North). The ace king and a third diamond followed and Steve ruffed with the ace, overruffed in dummy. Had South woderly exited with a heart declarer would simply have ruffed and raked his
