♣ The percentage line, in abstract, maybe the Jucesse but Tony knew that North had only 5 cards in Spades and Diamonds. Therefore, if he had the club king he was almost sure to have 3 or more hearts, and thus be squeezed. So Tony rose with the ~~club~~ <sup>club</sup> ace, and later discarded the club on the South heart.
