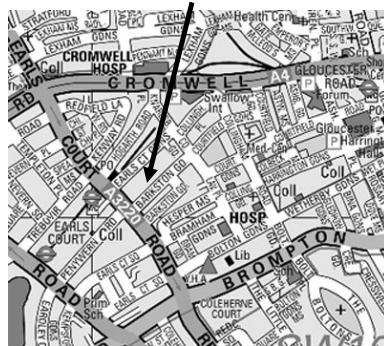
**HOW TO GET THERE**

**By Underground:** Piccadilly and District Lines to  
Earls Court. Take the Earls Court Road exit, turn  
right, and Barkston Gardens is shortly on your left,  
opposite Marks & Spencer.

**By Car:** Turn into Earls Court Road from the A4  
Cromwell Road. Barkston Gardens is the second on  
the left after the Tube station.



**Parking:** On Saturday, some street parking is  
available (metered or pay and display until 1.30 pm)  
around and to the east of Collingham Road, one  
block east of the venue. Do not park in the  
residents' bays. No restrictions apply on Sunday –  
you can park in the residents' bays and on single  
yellow lines
