## HOW TO GET THERE

**Address:** Central Hall Westminster, Storey's Gate, Westminster, SW1H 9NH

*The actual venue within the Central Hall is the Aldersgate Room,*



**By Public transport:** The venue is just off Parliament Square, close to both St James's Park and Westminster tube stations. Victoria Station is a 15-minute walk or short bus ride away.

**By Car:** On street parking on single yellow lines and in paid-for bays is free at weekends in the adjacent D4 parking zone. You can also park freely in residents' parking zones on Sundays. Available spaces are very limited, however, and public transport is recommended for such a central venue.

**Please allow plenty of time to reach the venue by any method, because of traffic & road/rail works, always bad in central London at weekends.**

### REFRESHMENTS

The Central Hall Westminster has its own café – Wesley's Café – which is immediately adjacent to the Aldersgate Room. Reasonably priced teas, coffees etc will be available from here during most of each day, as well as snacks and meals in the breaks. There are also many food and drink outlets in the nearby area.

Please note that the venue is a Methodist Church property, and **no alcohol is permitted on the premises.**

## ENTRY FEES

The entry fee is £50.00 per pair in the Swiss Pairs and £100 per team in the Swiss Teams. This equates to £25 per person per day, but anyone playing on both days is entitled to a discount and need pay £48 only for the whole weekend.
